

DECLARATION

[REDACTED] declares and states as follows:

1. I regularly attend the Veteran's Memorial Senior Center in Redwood City, California. I also occasionally go on bus trips to Reno, Nevada with groups from the senior center.
2. Within the last month, I have overheard a woman talking about the Scott Peterson murder trial. I know this woman by sight, although I do not know her personally and have never spoken to her. I believe her name is [REDACTED]
3. During a bus trip to Reno sponsored by the Veteran's Memorial Senior Center in Redwood City, California, I recently overheard this woman say that she was a potential juror in the trial of Scott Peterson and that she had passed some sort of test. She further stated that "he (Scott Peterson) was going to get what's due him."
4. In March I took a bus trip to Reno, Nevada. This woman was on the same bus within earshot. The trip took approximately seven hours, including a breakfast stop. During that time period, the woman talked extensively about being in the jury pool and matters regarding the Scott Peterson trial. She said that she was trying as hard as she could to pass the test and to not appear biased. She said that she would try to become "in charge" which I interpreted as being the foreperson of the jury. She said that "he (Scott Peterson) was as guilty as hell." She said she had been following the case for a year and knew all about it.
