I was a passenger on a Chartered bus trip leaving Redwood City, CA on 3/18/04 for Reno, NV.; returning on 3/19/04. It is a monthly trip. I was seated on the driver's side in a window seat next to [REDACTED] who had the aisle seat. We were some where in the middle of the bus going front to rear.

There was a loud talking woman seated behind me. I never engaged her in conversation but some where along the trip I learned her name was [REDACTED]. I have never seen her before and am not sure I would recognize her if I passed her on the street. [REDACTED] was seated next to an Asian woman. I have never seen [REDACTED] on the bus trips before.

I overheard her talking on the way to Reno. I overheard her talking about her children and her family. I never heard her say anything regarding the Peterson trial or being on a jury. [REDACTED] asked her to be quiet on the return trip so people could rest.

I never talked to anyone who said they heard her talking about the Peterson trial or being on a jury. [REDACTED] never told me that he had heard her talking about the Peterson trial. [REDACTED] sleeps most of the time when he goes on the trips. On the return trip to Redwood City he moved away from the loud talking lady ([REDACTED]) so he could rest. He set one seat forward and across the aisle where [REDACTED] had been seated. [REDACTED] moved next to me.
